- Official High School Transcript with appropriate seal. (Note: Student copies will NOT be accepted.);
- G.E.D. Certification of at least 78 or a GPA of 2.5;
- A Completed Application which includes:
  - A completed application form
  - A typed 300 to 500-word essay
  - Three letters of recommendation (e.g. school, church and community leaders, and employers are acceptable). Letters of recommendation from relatives will NOT be accepted.

**\*NOTE: ALL APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS MUST BE INCLUDED TO BE CONSIDERED FOR AN AWARD.**
